

SIX PRACTICES IN SITTING WITH JESUS

1. Recognize the presence of Jesus.

Jesus is always present. We do not need to invite him, ask him, or wonder if he is there. However, we do need to turn our attention toward him. You may not physically see, hear, or feel him But you can inwardly sense him present.



(Jesus in transparent form represents his spiritual body rather than his phsyical body.)

2. Connect heart to heart by crossing the devotional threshold.



One does not automatically connect with Jesus like doing pushups. It takes a heartfelt welcome for your heart to connect with his.

When that is difficult for me to do, I ask myself "How would I feel if the Jesus that walked the earth 2000 years ago was standing here next to me, how would I feel?"



3. Sit quietly in mutual awareness.

Be aware that Jesus is with you, loving you.

Know that Jesus is aware of you. He knows your name and everything about you. He knows what you need.

4. Communicate back and forth.

Say, think, feel, draw, or in whatever way fits for you, express your feelings and thoughts to Jesus. Listen for words, thoughts, images, sensations, feelings, or other ways Jesus might express himself to you.






5. Soak up the love and light

Like soaking in warm sunshine on a beautiful day, soak in the healing, nurturing energetic presence of Jesus. Sometime I place my hand on the part of my body than needs healing. Or I will picture another person I wish to be surrounded by the healing presence of Jesus.






6. Merge with Jesus.

(Transparent images represent spiritual bodies rather than physical ones)

You invite Jesus to come into you and become you as you become him. The two of you become one.

Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, a and they with me. Jesus - Rev. 3:20


Metamorphosis for the caterpillar is cooperating with its DNA to become what it is destined to be.

Metamorphosis for us is cooperating with our spiritual DNA to become what we are destined to be.




Maybe this is how it would look if we had some butterfly DNA . . .


