


Two Tee Shirts NOT to wear




Two Possibilities if you want theological correctness but don't mind looking silly

Jesus said to the religious leaders, "God and I are one." John 10:30

They answered, "It not for good works we are going to stone you, but for blasphemy, because you, though only a human being, are making yourself God." John 10:34


John 10:34-36

This was a widely understood metaphor of "family divinity likeness." By associating being children of God with being gods, the reasoning went like this:







It is not a matter of becoming who you are not.


It is becoming conscious of who you already are!
